3. Which of the following was the SECOND Triad high school to win a state championship?

- Page
- Grimsley
- Western Guilford
- Greensboro Day
- Southeast Guilford

ANSWER: Western Guilford, 2007 (SE Guilford won first championship in 2000)

4. Which Triad area high school last had a boys lacrosse team in 2010?

- North Forsyth
- Northeast Guilford
- Westchester Academy
- Southern Guilford
- High Point Andrews

ANSWER: Northeast Guilford

5. Which NC high school boys lacrosse team holds the record for most consecutive wins?

- Northwest Guilford
- Charlotte Catholic
- Middle Creek
- Providence
- Lake Norman

ANSWER: Middle Creek won 43 consecutive games (2017-2018)

6. Name three universities west of the Mississippi River who play Division 1 Men's Lacrosse.

ANSWER: Denver, Air Force, Utah (Notre Dame a popular answer, but east of Mississippi)

7. Who was the head coach of the team Cornell beat in 1971 to advance to the NCAA men's lacrosse title game? (first and last name)

ANSWER: Bud Beardmore (Maryland)

8. This player, who once played for Johns Hopkins, had a father who co-authored a 2001 book about a noteworthy college lacrosse team. Name the player (first and last name). For a bonus, name the father's profession.

ANSWER: Kyle Harrison (father, Miles, who co-authored *Ten Bears* (about Morgan St lacrosse) is a surgeon)

9. In which city and state and year was the NCAA men's lacrosse championship game played in which the least amount of goals ever were scored by the losing team?

ANSWER: Foxborough, MA, 2012 (Maryland lost to Loyola, 9-3)

10. Which of the following is true?

- Princeton won 4 consecutive NCAA men's lacrosse championships in the 1990's.
- The head high school boys lacrosse coach south of the Mason-Dixon line with the most all-time wins has the initials "TD".
- Oliver Bacon of Charlotte Country Day is the top all-time points (goals & assists) scorer in NC high school lacrosse history.
- Liam Banks had 104 assists for Ward Melville (NY) HS during the 1995 season.
- None of the above is true.

ANSWER: None of the above is true. Partial credit given for Liam Banks answer, which is correct except that it happened in 1998 not 1995

3. The all-time goalie saves leader in NC high school boys lacrosse attended which high school?

- Page
- Bishop McGuinness
- Mt Tabor
- Western Guilford
- RJ Reynolds

ANSWER: Bishop McGuinness (Will Quinn saved 927 shots from 2014-2017)

4. A player carries the ball in the offensive half of his field with no opponent near him. As he is running, one of his arm pads falls off. The player then shoots and scores. Under current NFHS rules for boys lacrosse, what should happen?

- Goal counts.
- Goal counts, but the offensive team must then serve a 30-second penalty.
- Goal counts, but offensive team must then serve a 1-minute penalty.
- Goal does NOT count.

ANSWER: Goal counts. Rule 4-24 (Situation and Ruling 4.24.6)

5. In which year did NC high school boys lacrosse first play as a state-sanctioned sport?

- 1995
- 2000
- 2005
- 2007
- 2010

ANSWER: After playing lacrosse as a club sports since the 1990's, NC high school teams first played under the NC High School Athletic Association in 2010.

6. Who is the all-time leading goal scorer in NCAA Division 1 men's lacrosse history?

- Paul Gait
- Lyle Thompson
- Zach Greer
- Rob Pannell
- Justin Guterding
- Matt Danowski
- Casey Powell
- None of the above

ANSWER: Justin Guterding, Duke, scored 212 goals in 75 games between 2015-2018. Two other Duke players, Zack Greer and Max Quinzani, are 2nd & 3rd all-time, respectively.

7. Which of the following is FALSE regarding the history of lacrosse?

- Tewaathon and Baggataway are names used in the past to reference lacrosse.
- The first intercollegiate lacrosse game in the United States was played in 1877 between New York University and Manhattan College.
- The first intercollegiate lacrosse tournament, held in 1881, was won by Johns Hopkins.
- The men's lacrosse programs at Johns Hopkins and Lehigh were both founded before 1900.
- The three oldest high school boys lacrosse programs in the United States are Phillips Academy Andover, Phillips Exeter, and Lawrenceville School.
- All of the above are true.

ANSWER: The third answer, regarding the first intercollegiate lacrosse tournament. It was won by Harvard. Hopkins lacrosse did not start until 1883. Partial credit given for All of the Above are true.

8. Since the 1980 start of the split D2/D3 NCAA lacrosse tournament, which D3 men's lacrosse team has won the most championships?

ANSWER: Hobart. Since Hobart is now a D1 team and the question did not specify whether it refers to former or current D3 team, partial credit was given for Salisbury.

9. Which of the following is FALSE regarding professional lacrosse?

- The Whipsnakes won the 2019 Premier Lacrosse League championship.
- The Chesapeake Bayhawks won the 2019 Major League Lacrosse championship.
- The leading goal scorer during the 2019 Premier Lacrosse League was Matt Rambo.
- The most goals scored by an individual player in a Major League Lacrosse game is eleven.
- This Major League Lacrosse season, if played, represents the 20th anniversary season.
- All of the above are true.

ANSWER: Second answer. While Rambo led in points (goals and assists), Marcus Holman led the league in goals with 23.

10. BONUS QUESTION: Which of the following is true under current NFHS Boys Lacrosse Rules? (check as many as apply)

- The center (or midfield) line on the field must be marked with a bold white line.
- A protective cup is required for all players.
Protective cup recommended but not required.
- The goal line must be marked with a line 4 inches wide.
The minimum amount of field players required to continue a game is seven.
- Goal line must be 2 inches wide
- Goal nets must be white unless both coaches agree otherwise.
The officials' authority in a lacrosse game ends when the game ends.
- Goal nets may be any solid color.
Authority ends when they "leave the immediate playing facility."
- Unless both coaches agree otherwise, the ball shall be white.
A goalkeeper in the crease may legally catch the ball with his hand.
- Goalie may use hand to block or bat away a ball in the crease. He may not catch it.
- All players on the same team shall wear uniform shorts of the same dominant color.
- During a dead ball a timeout may only be called by a member of the team on the field or by the head coach.

ANSWER: The answers marked with an "x" are correct.
